2b ARCHIBALD DOUGLAS, 3rd EARL OF DOUGLAS, called 'The Grim'; *b* c 1325; fought alongside his cousin 1st EARL (*see* below) at Battle of Poitiers against the English 19 Sept 1356; *Ld* Warden Marches 1368-1400; *m* c 23 July 1362 Lady Joan, only child of Maurice Moray, 1st Earl of Strathearn of the Feb 1343/4 *cr*, and widow of Sir Thomas Moray, feudal *Ld* of Bothwell, and *d* between 24 Dec 1400 and 9 Feb 1400/1, leaving:

1c ARCHIBALD DOUGLAS, 4th EARL OF DOUGLAS; *b* c 1370; *Ld* Warden Marches 1400; led a Scottish expdn into England 1401; captured by Harry Hotspur (*see* NORTHUMBERLAND, D) Battle of Homildon Hill (in which the 4th EARL lost an eye) against English 14 Sept 1402; joined Hotspur in rebellion against HENRY IV and was captured Battle of Shrewsbury 1403, following which held prisoner by English till 1408; feudal *Ld* Annandale 1409; *Lt* Gen in French serv and *cr* 19 April 1424 DUKE OF TOURAINE (France), with remainder to heirs male of his body; *m* by 1390 Lady Margaret Stewart, est dau of ROBERT III (then Earl of Carrick), and was *kr* 17 Aug 1424 at defeat of French and their Scottish allies by the English at Verneuil, leaving an only surv s:

1d ARCHIBALD DOUGLAS, 5th EARL OF DOUGLAS and 2nd DUKE OF TOURAINE, also *cr* *vp* COUNT OF LONGUEVILL, Normandy, by CHARLES VII OF FRANCE; a Scottish *Amb* to English 1424 to negotiate ransom of JAMES I; Co-Regent Scotland 1437, *Lt* Gen of the Kingdom (of Scotland) 1438; *m* (papal dispensation 24 Feb 1422/3) Eupheme (*m* 2nd c 25 Feb 1440/1, as his 1st w, 1st Lord Hamilton; *see* ABERCORN, D), est dau of Eupheme, Countess of Strathearn in her own right (2nd holder of the 1371 *cr*), and *d* 26 June 1439, leaving:

1e WILLIAM DOUGLAS, 6th EARL OF DOUGLAS, 3rd and last DUKE OF TOURAINE and 2nd and last COUNT OF LONGUEVILL; *b* c 1424; rebelled with his yr bro, hence executed by beheading for high treason 24 Nov 1440, having *m* Janet, dau of 2nd Earl of Crawford (*see* CRAWFORD and BALCARRES, E); *dsp*, when the Dukedom and Countship expired and the *Ld*ships of Annandale and Bothwell ultimately passed to the Crown, though the *Ld*ship of Galloway passed to his sis

2e David; *dsp*

1e Margaret, called 'The Fair Maid of Galloway'; *m* 1st her cousin 8th EARL OF DOUGLAS (*see* below); *m* 2nd (*divorce* following his attainder) her cousin 9th EARL OF DOUGLAS (*see* below); *m* 3rd 1459/60, as his 1st w, 1st Earl of Atholl of the 1457 *cr* (*see* MORAY, E), and *d* by 1475

2c JAMES DOUGLAS, 7th EARL OF DOUGLAS and 1st EARL OF AVONDALE (S), as which *cr* c 1437, of Balveny, Banffshire, called 'The Great'; Warden W Marches; *m*(?) 1st(?) Lady Beatrice Stewart (*dsp* c 1424), dau of Robert, Duke of Albany; *m* 2nd(?) by 7 March 1425/6 Lady Beatrice Sinclair (attainted with her three est surv sons June 1455; *d* apparently in England by 8 Feb 1462/3), dau of 2nd Earl of Orkney of the 1379 *cr* (*see* CAITHNESS, E), and *d* 22 March 1442/3 or 28 March 1443, leaving, with other issue (all of whom died out in the male line by c 1506):

1d WILLIAM DOUGLAS, 8th EARL OF DOUGLAS and 2nd EARL OF AVONDALE; *b* c 1425; *ktd* 1430, *Lt* Gen of the Kingdom (of Scotland) 1443-49, Warden Marches 1450; *m* (papal dispensation for consanguinity 24 July 1444) Lady Margaret Douglas (*see* above) but was stabbed 22 Feb 1451/2 by JAMES II in person at Stirling Castle after attempting to mount opposition to the body of men

about the King's person who made up what may be called the 'Court' party; *dsp*

2d JAMES DOUGLAS, 9th and last EARL OF DOUGLAS and 3rd and last EARL OF AVONDALE, KG (c 1463), called 'Heriot-Muir'; twin with next yr bro; tried to take revenge for his er bro's death at the hands of JAMES II but initially made his peace with that King 1452 only to turn on him two years later and at the head of 40,000 followers publicly accuse him of murder, having meanwhile become involved in the Wars of the Roses in England, where he sided with the DUKE OF YORK against HENRY VI; back in Scotland his 40,000 followers melted away following the abandoning of his cause by his principal supporters, notably Lord Hamilton (see ABERCORN, D), and he was attainted 10 and 12 June 1455 and stripped of his titles; fled to England, where received graciously by both EDWARD IV and HENRY VI, despite their representing contending factions in the Wars of the Roses; the Scottish Parl issued a proclamation 1484 granting a reward for his apprehension and death, whereupon he marched into Scotland at the head of an army under himself and the Duke of Albany; JAMES II beat him and Albany 22 July 1484 at the Battle of Kirtle (between Lochmaben and Carlisle) and held him captive at Lindores Abbey; *m* 1st c 26 Feb 1452/3 his cousin Lady Margaret Douglas (see above); *m* 2nd Anne, dau of John Holand, Duke of Exeter, and widow of (a) Sir John Nevill(e) (s of 2nd Earl of Westmorland of the 1397 *cr*; see ABERGAVENNY, M), and (b) 1st Lord (Baron) Nevill of the 1459 *cr* (also see ABERGAVENNY, M), and *dsp* shortly after 22 May 1491

3d ARCHIBALD DOUGLAS, regarded as EARL OF MORAY from 3 July 1445, when took seat in Parl, by virtue of his marriage and the power of the DOUGLASES (see MORAY, E, preliminary remarks); rebelled against JAMES II alongside his er bro 9th EARL OF DOUGLAS in revenge for the murder of his est bro 8th EARL (see above), following which JAMES took the Earldom into the possession of the Crown; rose in rebellion a second time and was defeated and k Arkinholm 1 May 1455, being posthumously attainted and formally stripped of his title 12 June 1455; *m* between Aug 1434 and 26 April 1442 Elizabeth (*m* 2nd (*divorce* by 10 March 1459/60) 2nd Earl of Huntly (see HUNTLY, M); *m* 3rd, as his 2nd w, Sir John Colquhoun of Luss; see COLQUHOUN OF LUSS, Bt), yr dau of 4th Earl of Moray of the March 1371/2 *cr* (see DUNBAR OF MOCHRUM, Bt), and *dsp*

4d HUGH DOUGLAS, 1st and last EARL OF ORMOND (S), so *cr* by 3 July 1445; won victory over English of Sark 23 or 24 Oct 1449; joined er bros in rebellion against JAMES II 1452; Sheriff Lanarks 1454; *dsp*, being captured after defeat by JAMES II at Arkinholm 1 May 1455, stripped of his title, attainted and executed

5d John (Sir), feudal Ld of Balveny, of which stripped 1455 for rebellion; fled to England but returned and was executed Edinburgh c July 1463; *dsp*

6d Henry; priest

7d George; *d unnm* aged c 14

2a Hugh; feudal Ld of Douglas, which renounced 1342 in favour of his n 1st EARL OF DOUGLAS (see below); *d unnm*

* 3a Archibald (Sir); Regent Scotland April-July 1333; *m* Beatrix, dau of Sir Alexander de Lindsay (see CRAWFORD and BALCARRES, E), and was k 19 July 1333, leaving a 2nd but only surv s:

+ 1b WILLIAM DOUGLAS, 1st EARL OF DOUGLAS (S), as which *cr* 26 Jan 1357/8; of age by 1348; present Battle of Poitiers 1356, where wounded fighting alongside the French against the English; *m* probably just prior to 13 Nov 1357 Margaret, Countess of Mar (*qv*) in her own right, and adopted her Earldom as his own by 21 June 1374; *d* May 1384, having had, with other issue (see MAR, E):

* 1c JAMES DOUGLAS, 2nd EARL OF DOUGLAS and by sources writing long after his death referred to from time to time as Earl of Mar in right of his mother; *b* c 1358; *ktd* 1378; *m* c 23 Sept 1371 Isabel, dau of ROBERT II by his 2nd w Eupheme, and *dsp*sl, being k Battle of Otterburn (see NORTHUMBERLAND, D) c 19 Aug 1388, leaving illegitimate issue:

* 1d William (Sir); granted (territorial) Barony of Drumlanrig, Dumfries; cdr in wars with England, envoy to England to negotiate release of JAMES I 1412; granted confirmatory charter 1412 of (territorial) Baronies of Drumlanrig (in Durisdeer, Upper Nithsdale, Dumfriesshire), Hawick and Selkirk; *m* Elizabeth, dau of Sir Robert Stewart of Durrisdeer, and was k France 1427, leaving:

+ 1e William (Sir), 2nd of Drumlanrig; *m* Jean, dau of Sir Herbert Maxwell of Carlaverock, and *d* 1458, leaving:

* 1f William, 3rd of Drumlanrig; present Siege of Roxburgh 1460 and Battle of Alnwick 1462; *m* Margaret, dau of Sir William Carlyle of Torthorwald, and *d* 1464, leaving:

* 1g William (Sir), 4th of Drumlanrig; *ka* 22 July 1484 Battle of Kirtle, fighting for the Crown against his cousin 9th EARL OF DOUGLAS (see above), who had invaded from England, leaving:

* 1h James, 5th of Drumlanrig; *m* 1470 Janet, dau of David Scott of Buccleuch (see BUCCLEUCH and QUEENSBERRY, D), and *d* 1498, leaving:

* 1i William (Sir), 6th of Drumlanrig, of which, with Drumlanrig Castle, granted charter 1492, also charters of land in Dalgarnock 1500 and the (territorial) Baronies of Tibberis 1509 and Hawick 1511; *m* Elizabeth, dau of Sir John Gordon of Lochinvar (for whose earlier ancestry

see HUNTLY, M), and was *ka* Flodden 9 Sept 1513, leaving:

1j JAMES (Sir)

2j Robert; Provost Lincluden; ancestor of the DOUGLASES of Burford

1j Janet; *m* after 4 July 1509, as his 1st w, 4th Lord Maxwell (see MAXWELL OF MONREITH, Bt)

1i Janet; *m* Roger Grierson (see GRIERSON OF LAG, Bt) and had issue

* 1a JAMES DOUGLAS, 2nd Earl of Queensberry; *b* 8 Jan 1621/2; royalist Civil War, hence imprisoned Carlisle 1645; by the Restoration he had been fined or otherwise lost £234,879 Scots (well over £6,300,000 in early-2000s terms); *m* 1st (contract 4 June 1630) Mary (*dsp* 29 Oct 1633), yst dau of 2nd Marquess of Hamilton (see HAMILTON and BRANDON, D); *m* 2nd (contract 26 March 1635) Margaret, dau of 1st Earl of Traquair (see MORAY, E), and *d* 1671, having by her had:

1b WILLIAM DOUGLAS, 1st Marquess of Queensberry, so *cr* (as QUEENSBERRIE (*sic*)) 11 Feb 1681/2, as also EARL OF DRUMLANRIG AND SANCHAR, VISCOUNT OF NITH, TORTHORWALD AND ROSS AND LORD DOUGLAS OF KINMONTH, MIDDLEBIE, AND DORNOCK (all S), with remainder to his heirs male whatsoever, and 3 Nov 1684 DUKE OF QUEENSBERRIE (*sic*), MARQUESS OF DUMFRIESHYRE (*sic*), EARL OF DRUMLANRIG AND SANQUHAR, VISCOUNT OF NITH, TORTHORWALD AND ROSS, LORD DOUGLAS OF KINMONTH, MIDDLEBIE AND DORNOCK (all S), with remainder to heirs male of

his body, PC (S Jan 1666/7-74, E 1685-Feb 1688/9), JP (1663); b 1637; Commr Excise 1661, Sheriff and Coroner Dumfriesshire 1663 and 1669, Cdr Dumfriesshire Horse Militia 1668, Ld Justice-Gen Scotland 1680-82, Exdry Ld Session 1681-86 and 1693-95, Ld High Treasurer Scotland 1682-86, Constable and Govr Edinburgh Castle 1682-86, Ld HC to S Parl 1685, Commr Treasury 1695; m 1657 Isabel, dau of 1st Marquess of Douglas (see HAMILTON and BRANDON, D), and d 28 March 1695, having had, with a yr s (George, d unm):

1c JAMES DOUGLAS, 2nd Marquess of Queensberry, 2nd DUKE OF QUEENSBERRY etc and 1st DUKE OF DOVER, as which cr 26 May 1708, as also BARON RYDON, Co York, and MARQUESS OF BEVERLEY, Co York (all GB), with remainder to his 3rd s Charles and the latter's yr bro in tail male, KG (1701) PC (S 1684 and 1689, GB 1707); b 18 Dec 1672; Provost Dumfries 1683, a Ld Exchequer 1685 and 1690, Lt-Col Dundee Horse 1684, Col 6th Scots Horse Gds, Gentleman Bedchamber 1689-1702, a Commr Treasury Scotland March 1691/2-1704 and 1705-07, Actg Ld High Treasurer Scotland 1694, Ld Privy Seal Scotland 1696-1702 and 1705, Exdry Ld of Session 1696-1711, Ld High Commr S Parl 1700, 1702, 1703 and 1706, a Ld Treasury Scotland 1705, rep S peer 1707-08, Jt Keeper Privy Seal July 1709, 3rd Pncpl Sec State with responsibility for Scotland Feb 1708/9-11; was regranted 17 June 1706 all his 1684 titles to him and his heirs of entail succeeding to the Queensberry estates and descended from the 1st Earl and he settled them on his 3rd s, bypassing his 2nd and then est surv s; m 1 Dec 1685 Mary, sis of 2nd Earl of Cork (see CORK and ORRERY, E), and d 6 July 1711, having had:

1d William, Earl of Drumlanrig; b 18 May, dvp 21 Oct 1696

2d JAMES DOUGLAS, 3rd Marquess of Queensberry; b 2 Nov 1697; homicidal maniac, probably congenital, but certainly by 17 June 1706 when he was bypassed in entail of the estates and the 1684 titles (see above); known as 'The Cannibalistic Idiot' from his slaughtering, then spitting and roasting a young scullion in the Holyrood kitchens after being left unattended in his cell there by his keepers, they having gone to enjoy the Edinburgh riots over the Act of Union 1707; bur 17 Feb 1714/5

3d CHARLES DOUGLAS, 4th Marquess of Queensberry, also 3rd DUKE OF QUEENSBERRY etc and 2nd and last DUKE OF DOVER etc, PC (1726); b 24 Nov 1698; cr vp 17 June 1706 EARL OF SALLWAY (sic), i.e., Solway), VISCOUNT OF TIBBERIS and LORD DOUGLAS OF LOCKERBIE, DALVEEN AND THORNHILL (all S), with remainder to his yr bro; a Ld Bedchamber 1720-27, Ld-Lt Dumfriesshire and Kirkcudbrightshire 1721, V-Adml Scotland 1722-29, Capt-Gen Roy Co Archers 1758-78, Keeper Gt Seal of Scotland 1761-63; m 10 March 1720 Catherine (Kitty), dau of 4th Earl of Clarendon (qv, preliminary remarks) of the 1661 cr, and d 22 Oct 1778, when all his titles cr 1706 and 1708 expired, having had:
