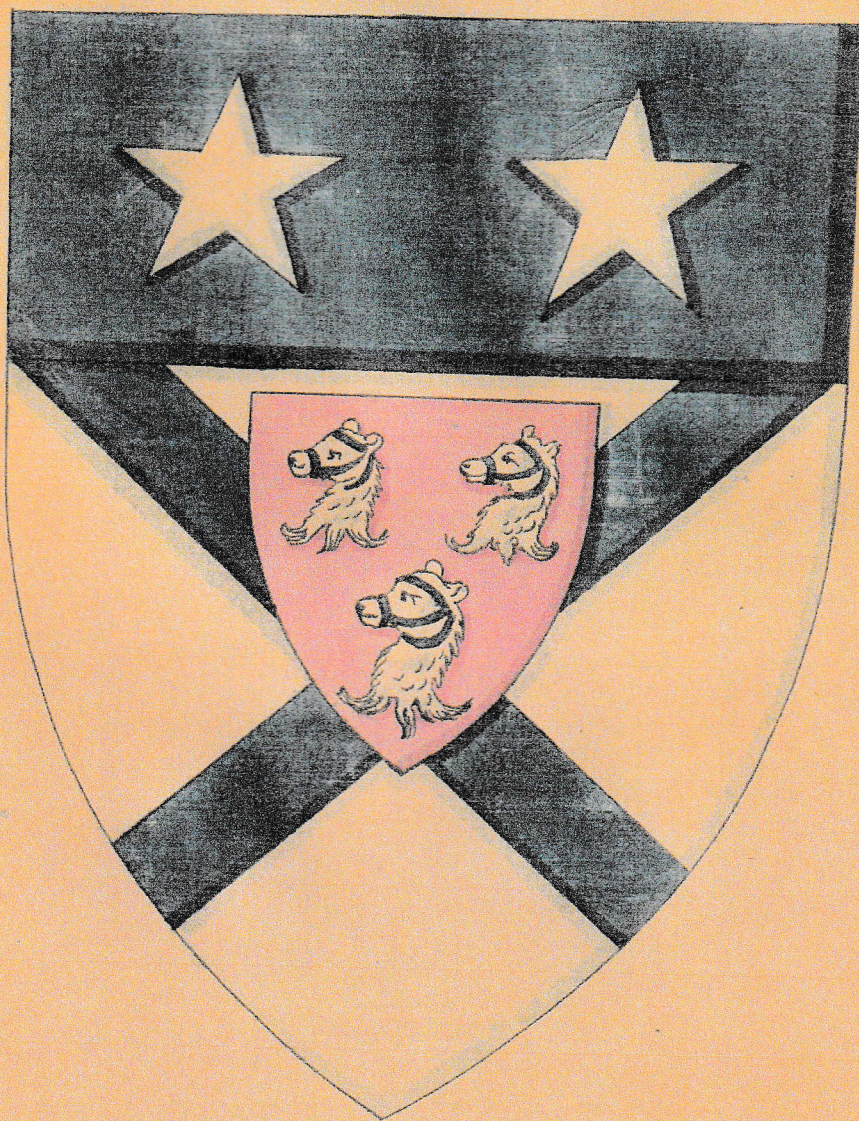

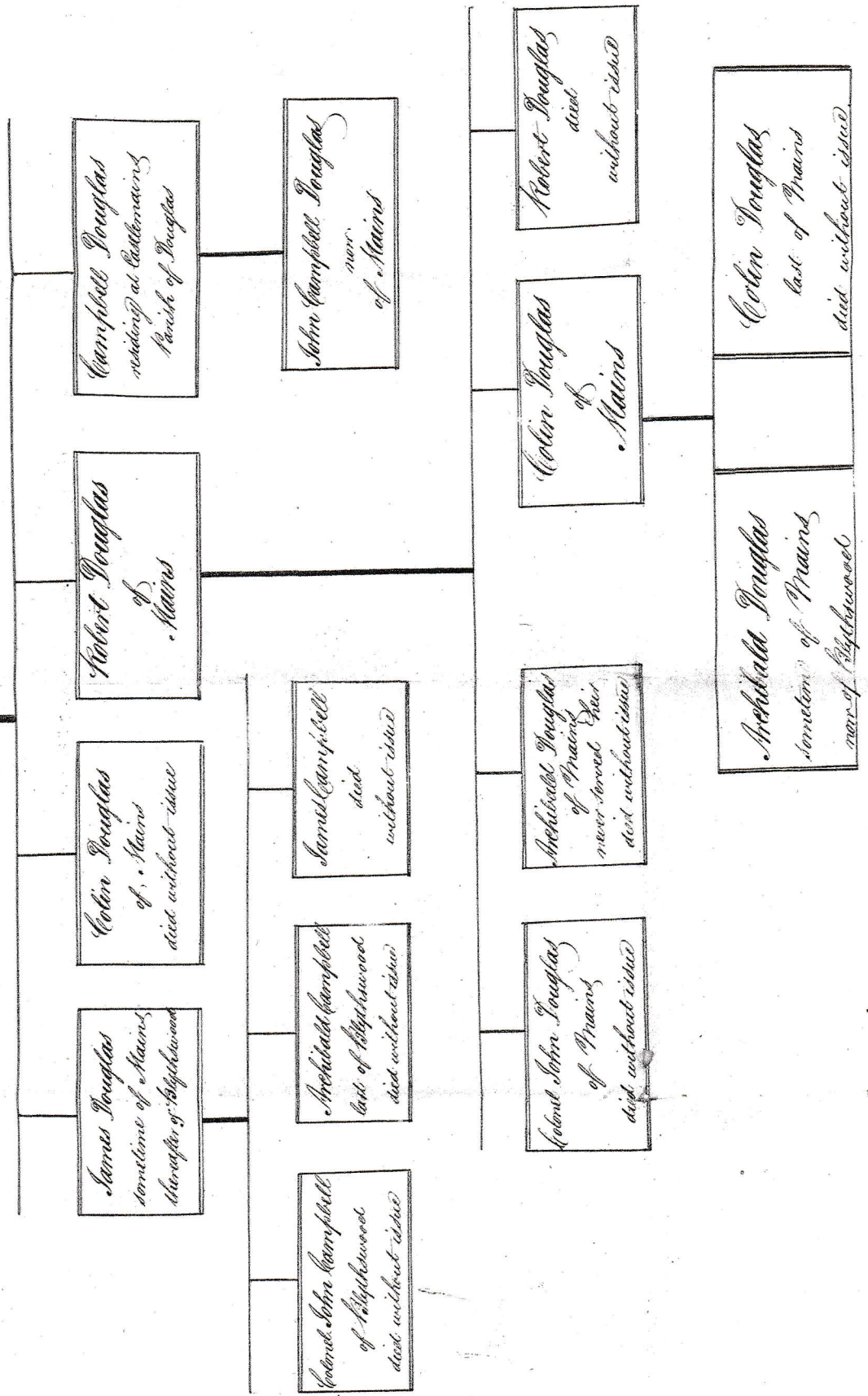

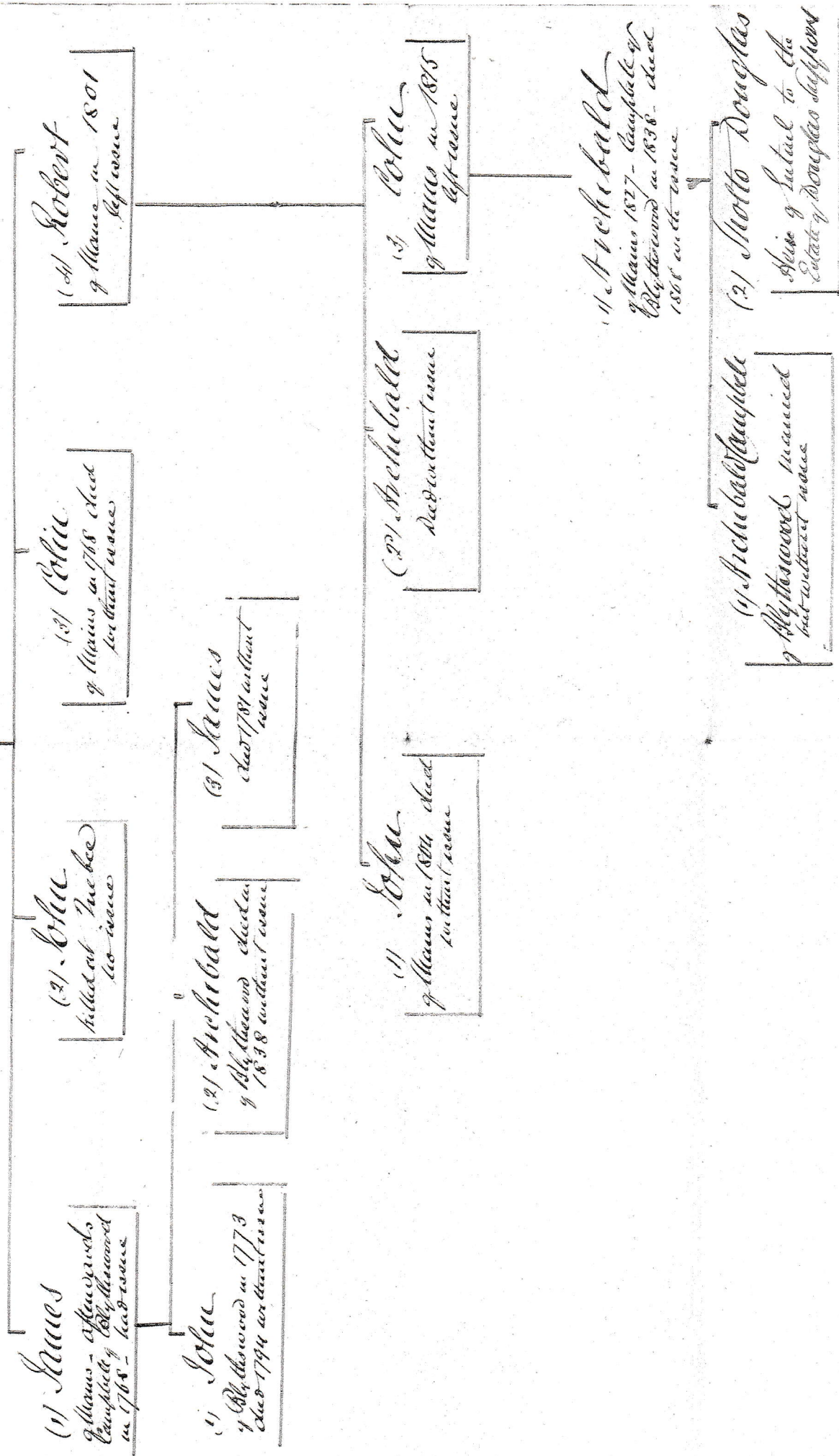

John Douglas & Mearns  
died 1758 leaving issue

1<sup>st</sup> Mearns who succeeded to train  
in 1756 and to Plymwood in 1768. had  
issue

2<sup>nd</sup> John succeeded to train on his  
father's issue taking Plymwood and  
1801 without issue

3<sup>rd</sup> Robert succeeded to train 4<sup>th</sup> Campbell  
John died 1803 & left issue

1<sup>st</sup> John who succeeded  
his father & died unmarried  
1795

2<sup>nd</sup> Archibald succeeded his  
father John - died unmarried  
in 1838

1<sup>st</sup> John succeeded to Fettercairn  
died 1815 without issue

2<sup>nd</sup> John succeeded to Fettercairn  
John 1815 - died 1827 leaving  
issue

1<sup>st</sup> Archibald who succeeded his  
father and then to Plymwood in 1838  
died 1888 leaving issue note above

2<sup>nd</sup> John who succeeded his  
father in Mearns

1<sup>st</sup> Archibald also succeeded his  
father in Plymwood & thereby  
debarred from pursuing Douglas  
succession

2<sup>nd</sup> John the Mearns was  
admitted to succeed John  
in the Newcastle Douglas  
in Douglas Succession

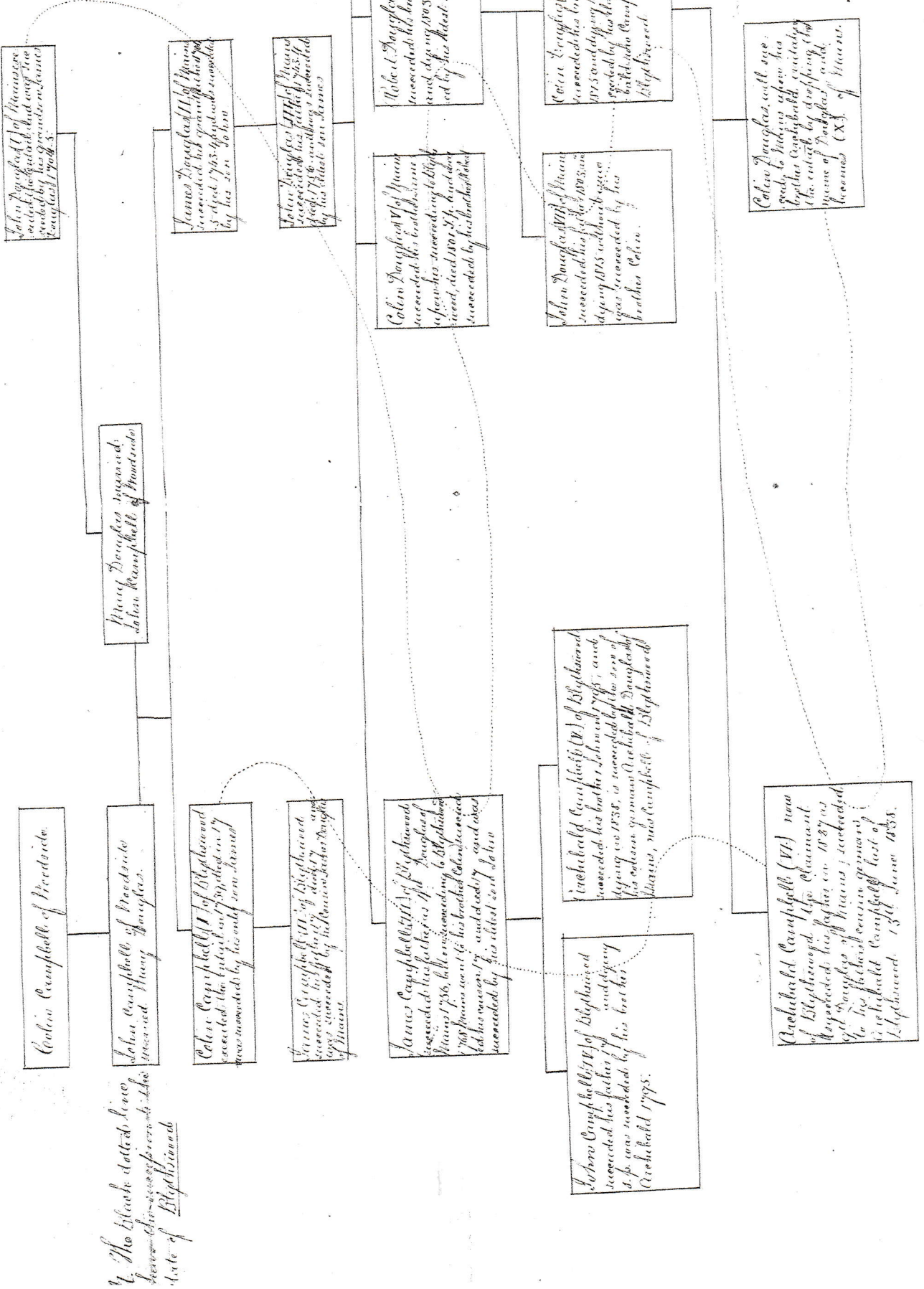

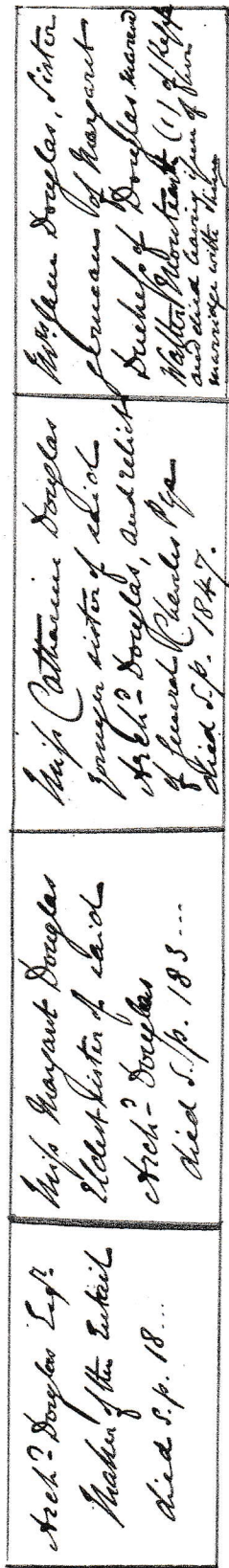
