 the Faith &c. William Dunn Esq. signed sealed
 published and declared by the said Executor as and
 for his last will and Testament in the presence of
 us who have hereunto subscribed our names as
 witnesses in the presence of the said Testator -

This Will was proved at London the
 twenty fifth day of February in the year of our Lord
 one thousand seven hundred and ninety before the
 Right Honourable Sir William Wynne Knight Doctor
 of Laws Master of the Bench or Commissary of the
 prerogative Court of Canterbury lawfully constituted
 by the Oath of Edward Morris the sole Executor
 named in the said will to whom administration
 was granted of all and singular the Goods Chattels
 and Credits of the deceased having been first sworn
 by Commission duly to administer - &c

and Administrators of such Survivor do and shall with
all convenient speed as soon as may be after my
decease sell and convert such part of my personal
estate which shall not at the time of my decease be
in money into money and after payment of
my just Debts Legacies aforesaid funeral Expences
and the Expences attending the aforesaid sale and
of proving this my will which my desire is shall
in the first place be paid place the monies
arising by such sale with the residue of my
personal estate out at interest and from time to
time roll up and place the same out at interest
again as often as they the said Richard Dorell and
William Phillips or the survivor of them or the Executors
or Administrators of such Survivor shall think
proper or see occasion for so doing and pay out
moiety or half part of the interest profits or an
annual profit arising therefrom unto and into the
hands of my sister Sarah Garner wife of John
Garner of Hamton in the County of Northampton
during for and during the term of her natural life for
her sole and separate use and benefit and to be
except and free from the power Control Debts or
Demands or Engagements of her now or any after
born husband who my will is shall have no
intermeddling therewith and so that and my will is
that my said Executors shall retain the said moiety
or half part of the said interest in their hands as
against the husband of the said Sarah and pay
the same to the said Sarah as she shall have
occasion to make use thereof and that the Receipt of
the said Sarah only and notwithstanding her Coverture
to my said Executors for the said moiety or half of the
said interest or any part thereof shall be for so
much money as shall be expressed in such Receipt
or Receipts to be paid by my said Executors and
to be received by her of them a good and sufficient discharge
to them my said

Trustees as well against the said Sarah as against her

now or any after taken substance it being my mind
 and intention that the said Sarah shall notwithstanding
 her present or any future marriage have the sole
 and exclusive power of receiving using and disposing
 of the said moiety or half part of the said interest
 or of any part thereof in as unrestricted a manner
 as if she was sole and unmarried and the
 other moiety or half part thereof unto her sister
 Anne Wrighton for and during the term of life or
 natural life and from and immediately after the decease

 whom I do hereby give and bequeath the same
 accordingly and from and immediately after the
 decease of my said sister Anne Wrighton the same my
 will also is and I do hereby further direct the said
 Richard Lovell and William Phillips and the
 survivor of them and the Executors and Administrators
 of such survivor to call in the remaining moiety or
 half part thereof the said moiety so directed by me to
 be placed out at interest as aforesaid and equally
 divide and pay the same unto and amongst Ann
 Hobley Rose Robinson Sarah Wrighton and Elizabeth
 Wrighton daughters of my said sister Anne Wrighton
 to whom I do hereby give and bequeath the
 same accordingly provided that in case any or
 either of the children of my Brother in Law
 the said John Roy or in case any or either of the
 children of my said two sisters the said Sarah
 Garner and Anne Wrighton shall happen to
 depart this life leaving no issue of their body or
 lawfully begotten before they shall become entitled to
 the legacy or portion hereinafter by me given
 them then my will is that the legacy or portion
 of him her or them so dying shall go over and be
 paid to the surviving Brothers and Sisters of the
 child or children so dying as aforesaid in equal
 shares and proportions as such time and times as his
 her and their legacy or legacies portion or portions
 shall become payable but if such child or children
 so dying shall have issue then the legacy or
 portion of him her or them so dying shall go to his her
 or their issue provided also and my will further is that

my said Trusts or either of them their or either of
 their Executors or Administrators shall not be charged
 or chargeable with or accountable for any work of
 my Personal Estate or Monies here or there
 shall actually receive or shall come to his or their
 respective hands by virtue of this my Will nor with
 or for any loss which shall happen of the said
 Debts and Personal Estate so as such loss happen
 without their wilful default nor the one of them for
 the other of them but care of them for his own acts
 Debts Receipts Defaults or Disbursements only and also
 that it shall and may be lawful for them my said
 Trusts and Executors hereinafter named and a
 care of them their and care of their Executors and
 Administrators in the first place by and out of the
 said Monies and Personal Estate which shall come
 to their respective hands to deduct and reimburse
 themselves all such Sops Costs Charges and Expences
 as they or either of them shall sustain to pay or
 be out unto for or by reason of the performance of
 this my Will or the Trusts hereby in them imposed
 or the Management or Execution thereof respectively
 or any other thing in any way relating thereto
 and lastly I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint
 the said Richard Lovell and William Phillips
 Executors of this my last Will and Testament hereby
 revoking all former Wills by me at any time heretofore
 made In witness whereof I the said Elizabeth Douglas
 have to this my last Will and Testament contained
 in three sheets of paper at the bottom of each sheet
 thereof set my hand and seal this eighteenth day
 of May in the seventh year of the reign of our
 Sovereign Lord George the Third by the Grace of God
 of Great Britain France and Ireland King Defender of
 the Faith and so forth and in the Year of our Lord one
 thousand seven hundred and seventy six Elizabeth Douglas
 signed sealed published and declared by the said
 Elizabeth Douglas as and for her last and will and
 Testament in the presence of us who have at her
 request in her sight and presence and in the presence
 of each other subscribed our Names as Witnesses
 here to the Jurisdiction between the thirtieth and
 fourteenth lines of the first of the words "to hold to
