**Whereas** since the making of the above written  
 Codicil Richard Dorell one of the Trustees and Executors  
 of my Will and also my niece Elizabeth the daughter  
 of my sister Ann Wriggton hath departed this life the  
 said Elizabeth having intermarried with  Thomas Samuel  
 and left Thomas Samuel and William Barrett her children  
 now I do by this my second Codicil inrolled on my said  
 Will make and appoint Thomas White of Mollington  
 in the County of Oxford Yeoman a Co-executor of my  
 said Will with William Phillips the surviving Executor  
 thereof do give the said Thomas White two Guineas  
 as a Gratuity for his trouble therein and I do give to  
 the said Thomas White jointly with the said William  
 Phillips all <sup>the residue of</sup> my personal Estate by my said Will given to  
 the said Richard Dorell and William Phillips upon the  
 Trusts and for the purposes in my said Will and the  
 above written Codicil declared save only that if my Will  
 and I do direct the said Thomas White and William  
 Phillips and the survivor of them his Executors and  
 Administrators to pay all Debts both Principal and  
 Interest to which my said Will would have been  
 entitled to by virtue of my said Will unto the said  
 Thomas Samuel and William Barrett the sons of the  
 said Elizabeth equally share and share alike to be  
 paid to them respectively as they shall severally attain  
 the age of twenty one years to whom I do hereby give  
 the sum of  and I do direct that the Interest in the  
 same time shall be paid for and towards their maintenance  
 respectively and I do ratify all Bequests in my said Will  
 not hereby or by this or the above written Codicil made  
 in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal  
 the third day of  one thousand seven hundred

**This Will** was proved at London (with two Codicils  
the twelfth day of February in the year of our Lord one  
thousand four hundred and ninety before the Right Honourable  
Sir William Wynne Knight Doctor of Laws Master Keeper  
Commissary of the prerogative Court of Canterbury lawfully  
constituted by the Letters of William Phillips the Executor  
named in the said Will and Thomas White the Executor  
named in the second Codicil to whom Administration was  
granted of all and singular the Goods Chattels and  
Credits of the deceased having been first sworn by a  
Commission duly to administer &

**In the Name of God Amen**  
I Jacob Del Mare of the Parish of Kingston in the  
County of Surrey and Island of Jamaica but now of  
London Merchant being in health of Body and of sound  
and disposing mind memory and understanding praise be  
God for the same and being mindful of my Mortality  
do make this my last Will and Testament as follows that  
is to say I give to the Warden of the Jews Synagogue  
of the Parish of Kingston in Jamaica aforesaid for the  
use of the sum of fifty pounds Jamaica Currency for  
the use and benefit of the poor of the Jewish Nation  
immediately after my Decease I give the sum of one  
hundred and forty pounds Jamaica Currency unto  
Isaac De Isaac Bouriques the son of Isaac Bouriques  
of the Parish of Kingston aforesaid I give the sum of  
one hundred <sup>and fifty</sup> pounds Jamaica Currency unto Jacob  
Alvaranga son of Isaac Alvaranga of the Parish  
of Kingston aforesaid Doctor of Physick I give forty  
pounds Jamaica Currency unto Abraham Pinto of  
London the son of Abraham Pinto Merchant of  
Kingston aforesaid Gentleman and I direct my Executors  
hereinafter named to pay the said several Legacies to  
the said Isaac De Isaac Bouriques Jacob Alvaranga  
and Abraham Pinto Merchant with interest for the  
same Jamaica Currency when and so soon as they  
shall respectively attain their age of sixteen years but  
in case either of them shall happen to die before  
that time then the said Legacy of him or them so  
dying shall be lapsed and be considered as part of  
the residue of my Estate I give unto Sarah  
Daughter of Jacob Sara fifty pounds Jamaica  
Currency I give fifty pounds Jamaica Currency  
unto Judith Sara one other Daughter of the said  
Jacob Sara I give fifty pounds Jamaica Currency unto
