Know you that we confiding in your ability and integrity do by these presents appoint you the said Robert Douglas Esquire, to be Sergeant at Arms to the Legislative Assembly of Our Colony of Queensland during the pleasure of the Governor for the time being of Our said Colony and to do and perform all such lawful acts and deeds as shall under the Rules and Orders of the said Legislative Assembly or otherwise howsoever appertain to the said office.

In witness whereof Our Right Trusty and Entirely beloved Cousin and Councillor George Augustus Constantine Marquis of Normandy, Earl of Mulgrave Viscount Normandy, and Baron Mulgrave of Mulgrave, all in the County of York, in the Peerage of the United Kingdom, and Baron Mulgrave of New Ross in the County of Wexford, in the Peerage of Ireland, a Member of Her Majesty's Most Honorable Privy Council, a Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor and Commander in Chief of Our Colony of Queensland and its Dependences hath caused this Instrument to be sealed with the
